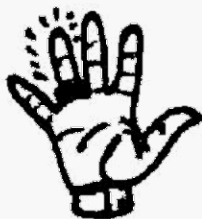


The Hand Staff: More Ways to Remember



Easy E is the pinky on the hand staff. We can remember this "easily" when we think of things that are so easy to do we can "easily" do them with our little finger!



Glamorous G isn't hard to find because of the big, Glamorous Ring! Not only is this the hand staff finger for G, it's also the finger we use to play G on our recorder!



Birdy B sits on the tallest finger, like he's in the tallest tree! He likes to be able to see everything!



Dizzy D is the pointer finger. When we point with this finger, curling our fingers around, we are making a letter "D" in American Sign Language!



Finish F is the thumb. When someone finishes a job, we give them a "thumbs up" to show that we think they did just great! So let's finish our hand staff with a "thumbs up"!

...and of course, if the note is in a SPACE, just think of your F-A-C-E!
